Shalom and Greetings Dear Friends,

Blessings in the mighty name of Jesus. We are so encouraged by what The Lord has done in both Costa Rica and in Liberia, Africa. We want to thank God and thank you so much for your prayers and committed partnership in this ministry The Lord has called us to. We want to update you on the last two outreaches. As you may know Henry is originally from Costa Rica. For the past 4 years The Lord has been moving on our hearts to establish a branch of World Mission Outreach for Latin America in Costa Rica. With the Lord's help, we were able to do this last year. The committee in Costa Rica has been working diligently to establish this branch. The beginning of this month we had an outreach and we thank God for those that participated and were saved. The local church is doing the follow up. We are excited about the many doors The Lord is opening with government officials. We have been invited back in April to do Messiah in the Passover teachings. The Lord is preparing the church to reach the Jews. Not only in Costa Rica, but in many other countries around the world. World Mission Outreach and Naomi Ruth Branches are clearly end time ministries. Our vision has always been evangelism to both Jews and Gentiles, Romans 1:16. We see that The Lord is extending our tent pegs. He is building a team all over the world. This is exciting yet humbling. We are so grateful to be a part of this end time harvest.



We just finished the 11th Missions Conference for Paynesville Community Church in Liberia, Africa. This is a relationship that developed from August of 2000 at a Billy Graham Conference in Amsterdam for preaching evangelists. We met so many Pastors there. The Lord connected us with a dear Pastor from Liberia who invited us to attend a missions conference in his country. At the time this was a dream he had to bring international speakers to this conference. Liberia was involved in a brutal civil war for over 20 years. We prayed and The Lord opened the door and within 5 months from that first meeting we were in Liberia. Through the years we have maintained our relationship with Pastor Wion and his wife Shirley and the church members. We have cried with them and laughed with them.

Liberia is a different place now. The country is not at war but recovering and rebuilding. It has been an honor and privilege to partner with Pastor Wion over the years. We have learned so much from this couples commitment to The Lord and to their flock. We love them dearly and thank God for this relationship. Over the years we have taught on the Jewish roots of the Bible and the House of Israel. The need to pray for the Jews to hear the gospel and the need for workers to bring the gospel. Liberians have been faithfully praying for us and this ministry for years. We have brought teams with us over years which have not only been a blessing but were blessed by their participation. We say all this to share how faithful The Lord God is. We had prayed at the last Missions conference that The Lord would make a way for Pastor Wion and Shirley to come to Israel and join the outreach we do at Pentecost. The Lord indeed heard the prayers and made a way for them to come. It was a great blessing to have them on our team. We can see how this trip encouraged the Paynesville Community Church (PCC) and many other Pastors.

The team The Lord gave us this year for Liberia was such a blessing. Two of the team members were also on the team in Israel two years ago with Pastor Wion and Shirley. They grew to love them and wanted to be a part of this Missions conference 2013. Our dear Messianic Jewish brother Edy from Romania who has been on two other campaigns with us in Wisconsin and in Germany also was on this team. So we were six. We wish so much you could have been there. What an incredible blessing this missions trip was. The Lord did more than we imagined. The two night outreach in a village was very well attended and many came forward to receive The Lord. PCC has established a work in this village. They are believing The Lord for a building. They have the property. We remember years ago going to this village and the church was a bamboo hut. This area is very dark with African traditionalism. Otherwise known as witchcraft. We had a few incidents in the days we were preaching and teaching on exposing the enemy. One day while

Henry was teaching at the Missions Conference we had a flood in the room we stayed in and all our luggage was flooded including our brief cases. Thank God Pastor Wion had to go back for something and heard the water running. Otherwise the whole house would have been flooded. We were praising The Lord we had our laptops with us at the seminars. It was a big shock to see all our documents, sermons, passports, etc, laying in the yard to dry. God is so faithful through these trials. Another incident was just before the outreach, the team went out to invite the people and a cobra snake fell out of a tree. Someone nearby with a big knife killed it quickly. There were a few other incidents that were intended for evil, that The Lord turned for good. We were so encouraged by the hunger of the Pastors and leaders to learn. The conference was very well attended. Over 50 churches participated. It was clear The Lord was in this. All the topics the speakers chose went so well together. So we would like to say THANK GOD and thank you! Someday you will have an opportunity to meet these brothers and sisters on the other side of eternity or perhaps join us for the next Liberia Missions conference February 2015 and meet them on this side. Either way you are a vital part of this ministry. We could not do this work without your partnership. It takes two. One to go and one to send. We both participate in the fruit for His Glory.



We are currently in Nepal teaching and equipping the church leaders on Jewish evangelism. We hope to move the Nepali Church to do a Israeli Outreach in Katmandu in the near future God willing. We have a precious Nepali Pastor Sam working with us. He has arranged for us to also teach in a more remote part of Nepal. So please pray for our safety as we travel by bus about 7 hours. Christiane has joined us here from Germany for both Nepal and Thailand. Thank you for praying for our team and for the Lord's will to be done. These are exciting times to be alive. There is so much to do and we are thankful for the strength The Lord gives us and the joy of bringing His Gospel to the lost. Both Jews and Gentiles. We will travel from Nepal to Phuket, Thailand to continue the work we begin with the

Jewish Outreach we did there in 2010.

Please let us know how we can pray for you. May The Lord bless you and your family. With our deepest love and gratitude.


