DEAR Partner and Friend,

Shalom and blessings in Jesus to you from The Himalayas, Nepal.

From the lowest part of the world (Dead Sea-Israel) to the highest part (Himalayas- Nepal) may Jesus the Lord God be lifted up. To Him belong all the high places. We thank God for His Faithfulness. Below is an update and also prayer requests please.

From February 17 to 28, we were equipping churches in central Kathmandu, Nepal on Jewish evangelism to prepare them for a future Jewish outreach. We also had the opportunity to share the Gospel of Jesus among the Nepalese people. Hinduism is strong here and Kathmandu is the world center of Shiva the “god of gods” in Hinduism. Back in Israel, we have been evangelizing at the New Age Festivals over the past 8 years and have seen how these young Israelis worship Shiva and even put this idol equal to the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. They are bringing this idolatry back to Israel from Nepal. Imagine that they hear the Gospel of Yeshua (Jesus) here in Nepal and bring Him back to Israel. This is our hope. We met many Pastors who meet Israelis trekking. We made sure they have lots of Hebrew New Testaments to give out. Please pray they get into the hands of the Israelis. We do thank God for the effectual open doors. We are truly blessed by the many divine appointments.

Amazingly there are 2 Jewish centers in Nepal to meet the spiritual “needs” of Jews living here and traveling Israelis by the thousands each year. We spent one Shabbat with the Jews at one of these centers. Certainly Nepal is the land of spiritual journey not only for Israelis but people from the whole world. Especially, the Himalayan mountain range filled with temples and spiritual centers. Maybe WMO should open a World Peace Center; where The Prince of Peace, The Lord God Jesus and His gospel is presented. Please pray about this, perhaps Jesus will do it! We also encouraged the young Nepalese leaders to pray about starting a 24/7 Prayer and Worship Center.

Once a year toward the end of February, Kathmandu becomes the capital of the world to celebrate and worship Shiva at a festival called “Shiva Ratri” (the night of Shiva). This is the home of Shiva. We went there to share the Gospel (with wisdom), to do a prayer walk and to understand the mindset. It is a very deep dark festival where millions of Hindu people stand in a long line to go into the temple of “Shiva” who the devotees claim is the lord of lords. We met a Nepalese man at this festival who lived in Saudi Arabia and he knew a personal friend who believed in Jesus that had shared with him. After hearing the Gospel again, he was encouraged that it isn’t too late for him to repent and get right with the Lord. Please pray for his salvation. The Lord God knows his name.



We thank God for Dorothy, a lady from Hong Kong whom we met in the mountains. She was visiting. After hearing the Gospel and love of God in Jesus, she made a profession of faith. She knows friends in Hong Kong to help her to grow in Jesus through discipleship. Please pray for Dorothy. We thank Jesus for this divine appointment.

Please pray for Alon, a young Israeli man who sat across from us at Shabbat dinner. That was last Friday. On Monday we ran into him on the street. This was such a divine appointment, which we had prayed for in the morning. Alon remembered us and we were able to share the entire Gospel with him and give him a New Testament in Hebrew. Alon is living in Nepal and speaks fluent Nepali. Please pray that the Lord will open his heart and spiritual eyes to THE TRUTH. It is so amazing to think that many of these Israelis which are living in Nepal and Thailand speak the local language. So even if many of the Nepalese or Thai believers don't speak English or Hebrew they can still communicate. The Lord is amazing!
