
Message from The Chairman of the Board

December 2018

Dear Friend and Co-Laborer in the Harvest,

As 2018 draws to a close, we prayerfully consider the support that we have received from you. Thank you for giving in support of World Mission Outreach, especially in light of what the Bible says about the importance and urgency of evangelism in the times in which we live.

In Luke 10:1-2, Jesus, after sending out His twelve apostles, appointed seventy others to go out two by two into every city and place where He Himself was about to go. Then, He said to them, "The harvest truly is



great, but the laborers are few; therefore, pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest." Jesus was reaching out to Jews in towns and villages in the region of the Sea of Galilee. He came to fulfill the law through His crucifixion before the destruction of the temple in 70 AD and ensuing terrible judgment on the Jewish nation. 70 men were empowered by the Holy Spirit to preach the Good News and prepare the hearts of Jews to meet their Messiah. The urgency of reaching out with the Gospel was evidenced by the manpower that Jesus called to the task and the shadow of the cross. Terrible judgment would come to the masses that would refuse to believe in Jesus and would die in their sins. Time was short.

Now, roughly 2000 years later, we proclaim the Gospel of grace in our Lord Jesus amidst the many indications that the end of the church age is approaching. The fact that Israel again is a nation state, and that Russia and Iran are operating in Syria to the north of Israel could lead to the fulfillment of the prophetic war of Gog and Magog in Ezekiel 38. We could be as close to judgment in the 21st century as Jesus was in the 1st century. Therefore, reaching as many people of all nations as possible with the Gospel and making disciples is of paramount importance and urgency in the light of Romans 1:16-17.

World Mission Outreach leaders, Henry and Darlene Matarrita, seek to emulate the role that Jesus took in training the 70 to reach out and introduce the Messiah to Jewish people. WMO teams equip pastors and church leaders for effective Gospel evangelism to Jewish people in their areas. WMO also conducts evangelistic outreaches to the local nationals in different countries throughout the world. Your support for World Mission Outreach with prayers and gifts is obedient to the Great Commission and a blessing to the Jewish people who come to know the Messiah. There is no greater way to show love to the Jewish people than to introduce them to Jesus. Genesis 12:3 says, "I will bless those who bless you."
