Year End Letter From Ed Wallick, Chairman of WMO

December 2019

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord Jesus,

As we approach Christmas time this year, some of us may quote John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believes on Him will not perish but have eternal life." But, what kind of love is this? Please follow along with me as I seek to answer this question in the balance of this letter to you, dear faithful donors to World Mission Outreach.

To understand the nature of God's love, let's examine Genesis 22:2 where God tested Abraham and said, "Take your son, your only son, whom you love-Isaac and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on a mountain I will show you." On the way to Moriah, Isaac noticed that they had wood for the fire and a knife, but no animal for the burnt offering. In Genesis 22:8, Abraham prophesied "God Himself will provide the lamb for the burnt offering, my son." God did indeed stop Abraham from sacrificing Isaac that day, and He provided the animal for the burnt offering. He tested Abraham, and found that he had the highest form of love for Him, which is SACRIFICIAL love, love that gives up something or someone precious to us for the betterment of another or a higher cause.

At the cross of Jesus, we see the embodiment of God's sacrificial love for fallen man. We show sacrificial love to God and others when we go against our natural selfish and self-centered tendencies to use our resources only for satisfying our own needs, wants, and desires, and instead, give to meet the needs of others. The Bible makes it abundantly clear that we are under God's wrath and cursed by God if we are without Christ. Therefore, the most loving thing that we can do is bring the Good News of Jesus Christ to the people of this world.

World Mission Outreach is about sacrificial love for Jew and Gentile all over the world. Your support for this ministry tells us that you have forgone just satisfying yourself with the things of this world, and that you are giving time, money, and energy that may leave you wondering who will meet your need. You may be anxious as the New Year approaches. In Philippians 4:15, Paul wrote "Now you Philippians know also that in the beginning of the gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church shared with me concerning giving and receiving but you only. For even in Thessalonica you sent aid once and again for my necessities. In verse 18, Paul called the gifts sent by the Church at Philippi an acceptable sacrifice, well pleasing to God. In verse 19, Paul then encouraged them with the words: "And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

With these things in mind, let us remember the sacrificial love that God the Father showed to us when He sent Jesus, and how we are called to show sacrificial love for others during this Christmas Season. I pray that our great merciful and gracious Heavenly Father will pour out His blessings on all of you, body, mind, and spirit so that we continue to experience His extravagant and generous gifts in this life, and in the life to come.
