Grace to you and peace from the God our Father and the Lord Jesus Messiah.

We are praying for you that you will not lose heart during this time of uncertainty. For we can be certain of God's Word and that HE will fulfill it. What a comfort and hope we have in Him.

Looking back to the day we arrived to Maui from the Big Island of Hawai'i where we had just completed our two week speaking engagement, things began changing radically. All of our meetings began to be canceled from Hawai'i, California and Wisconsin; and our calendar suddenly became empty. How fast our world changed. We had to adapt to these changes and graciously the Lord has allowed us to share the Word of God and to disciple believers in a local church; where the Lord opened a room for us to stay until we get back home. We have been teaching via live stream, and it has been a blessing. God in His wisdom instead allowed us to be back at the home base of World Mission Outreach here in Hawai'i to bless churches in proclaiming, equipping and mobilizing in evangelism. We have had many opportunities to share the Gospel with people and several have made a decision to follow Jesus.

We have learned to trust God in everything over the many years of serving Him in the field overseas, and it has prepared us for this moment. Our focus has always been on bringing people into a personal relationship with Jesus. The harvest is bringing people from unbelief to faith and from sin and destruction to eternal life. For me (Darlene), I find that there are times when I may be blind to the spiritual state of others, specifically in their readiness to receive Jesus. I don't always offer an invitation to receive Jesus. I don't think it's the same for Henry because he gives the invitation even if they seem unready. It is a good example for me. Jesus tells His disciples to become alert to the readiness of the harvest. To “open your eyes”, “look around you” and “lift up your eyes”. Jesus said to His disciples, ***“The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few”*** Matthew 9:37.

We thank God for some accepting Jesus as Lord and Savior.

The Lord Jesus and His Gospel are so real and so relevant. We see that the deeper the darkness; the greater the light shines. If the heart is willing and available to God, then God is able to reveal the Son of God (Matthew 16:16-17).

As an evangelistic ministry we realize how essential prayer is. On a personal side, the Lord has allowed us to take this time to seek Him and to pray for wisdom as He prepares us for the next step. We are scheduled to fly to Israel the first part of June, we appreciate your prayers that the Lord will use us as a light in the Middle East to many Jews and Muslims.

A young Jewish man named Matthew was invited to a *Messiah in the Passover* meeting we taught in March on the Big Island of Hawai'i. God convicted him and he asked many questions. He understood the Gospel message and knew he needed forgiveness of his sins. He put his trust in Jesus the Messiah as Lord God and Savior. We have been in touch with him since, and he has received follow-up through a board member of World Mission Outreach. The Lord has put in Matthew's heart a strong desire to follow HIM. We are in touch with him and he desires to go on a mission trip with us to Tanzania. We are so excited for what the Lord has for Matthew, and we thank you for your prayers for him.



New Life and a Future -

God is so faithful to answer prayers. We have prayed for the people of Venezuela. In the last year the Lord brought Venezuelans all the way from South America to Hawai'i. We shared the Gospel, and three have come to faith. This past week God again, in His grace and mercy here on Maui, allowed us to meet Alejandro from Venezuela. He just moved to Hawaii looking for a new life and a future; and after a long conversation Alejandro shared that he grew up Catholic, but did not know the Lord Jesus. He said it was only a tradition and ritual but not a relationship. After the Gospel of Jesus was explained, the Holy Spirit opened the heart of Alejandro to see God's love and the power of the cross, death and resurrection of Jesus and to understand eternal life. Alejandro made a decision of faith by the beach, and now is receiving follow up through a local church. Please pray for Alejandro, for his discipleship to grow in Jesus Messiah.

The Lord is so faithful. You are part of this team and God is using you to bring souls into HIS Kingdom. Your prayers and

financial support are vital to this ministry. May the Lord bless you and keep you.
