Israel Outreach May 2018

We thank God for this year's annual Israel outreach during the week of Pentecost which we conducted with our team members by the Sea of Galilee. We had team members from Costa Rica, Romania, Hawaii, Las Vegas, Chicago, Liberia West Africa, and from Israel. For the Jewish people, this feast is known as Shavuot (Weeks) because it occurs 7 weeks after Passover. Greek speaking Jews and many non-Jewish Christians called this day "Pentecost" because it occurs 50 days after the given day (Leviticus 23:16). This is one of God's appointed times from Leviticus 23. This feast has prophet significance as in all 7 feasts. The theme of Shavuot can be summed up by the word "revival".



The Holy Spirit

In Acts 2 we read about this festival and the Holy Spirit coming down and filling the believers. For the majority of Jews today, they do not know the New Testament observance. One of the joys we have is sharing the fulfillment from the Hebrew Scriptures.

With the destruction of the Temple in 70 AD, observance of Shavuot has changed. No more Temple and no more sacrifices. We know that Yeshua (Jesus) fulfilled the 3 previous feasts; Passover - He is the lamb of God, Unleavened Bread - He is the sinless eternal Bread of Life, and First Fruit - He is the first fruit of the Resurrection. The message of Shavuot is one of great hope and joy. It is still a time of remembering God's faithfulness; however, an additional tradition has evolved which is very interesting. This was the time that God gave the Law to Moses and the majority of Jews believe this covenant is still in effect.

Why is this so important? There is prophetic fulfillment. This law was broken and brought forth death; however, 2,000 years ago as written in Acts 1:8 the Lord promised to give His Holy Spirit which was the real fulfillment of Pentecost to empower us to be a witness of Him in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the whole world. Therefore, we have been entrusted by the power of the Holy Spirit and the Word of God to point the human race to the Messiah. The Holy Spirit is the guarantee of our inheritance, Ephesians 1:13-14. We can read about this fulfillment in Acts 2:1-5, 12.

Acts 2 reveals amazing details confirming the Jewish background of the New Testament Pentecost. Imagine the Jewish pilgrims that had come from all over the dispersion, hearing these Galilean disciples speaking various languages with such an exact "dialect" that they knew this was an irrefutable miracle! Peter was able to preach a powerful message about Messiah Yeshua, and 3000 Jews responded to salvation which is contrasted to the 3000 Jews that died in Exodus 32:28 by rejecting God.

Harvesting Fruit for Gods Kingdom

During this week of Pentecost 2018, our team members experienced the blessing in sharing the hope of the Messiah Yeshua to both Jews and Arabs in the land. Many Jews in Israel's society are influenced to think

according to what the Rabbis say which is called, "Rabbinic Judaism", and not according to what the Bible says which is called, "Biblical Judaism". Many have never heard what their prophets said regarding their Messiah.

Our team members were equipped to share scriptures like; Leviticus 17:11, Isaiah 53, and Jeremiah 31:31 which fulfills this New Covenant by Messiah Yeshua Himself in Luke 22:20. He is God's only begotten Son, being the precious sacrifice given by God to the world. "For God so loved the world that He gave His Only Son" John 3:16.

During this outreach many people were touched by the message of His love and seeds were planted, others were watered, and even some were harvested.

We thank God that 4 Israelis opened their hearts to receive the Messiah Yeshua and even 1 Arabic speaking Druze man received the Messiah. The Druze people are difficult to reach; they are a closed group descended from Jethro, the Father in law of Moses (Exodus 18:24).

Today everyone who received the Messiah Yeshua are getting follow-up. We understand how important the follow up is and partnering with local congregations, fulfilling the Lord's mandate to make disciples (Romans 1:16 and Matthew 28:19). We thank God for the opportunity to serve Him in this capacity as we Proclaim the Word, Equip the next generation, and Mobilize the Church. As Passover speaks of redemption and Shavuot of revival, this message is one of great hope and joy. Yeshua is the only hope for Israel and for the Nations.

Summer 2018

As summer is now here, we encourage you to pray and reach out to those around you with the love of God through the power of the Gospel. Just like the interval between the Spring Feasts and Fall Feasts, many signs indicate that summer is quickly drawing to a close and the fulfillment of the fall holidays is about to begin. Let us be ready for the return of Messiah and work to help bring in the harvest. We thank you for your prayers and support as we will be conducting evangelism work and equipping the congregations to do the same in the Northeast of the US, from the area of Burlington Vermont, to Plattsburgh, New York. We are really excited. As the Word says, "The harvest is ripe, but the workers are few, therefore, pray for the workers".
